## **Reporting Claims**

Although there can be no assurance that you will not experience some sickness, these cattle have been managed to minimize stress and immunized to increase their resistance to disease. All KY-CPH 45 ear tags can be traced to their farm of origin and **this number along with the letter code at the top of the tag** must accompany any complaints or claims for reimbursement. We ask that you report any sickness, to allow us to investigate potential problems and assist our cow/calf producers in insuring quality feeder cattle. Individual CPH 45 consignment forms and processing maps are on file. Any treatment information or claims requests should be sent to the University of Kentucky.
